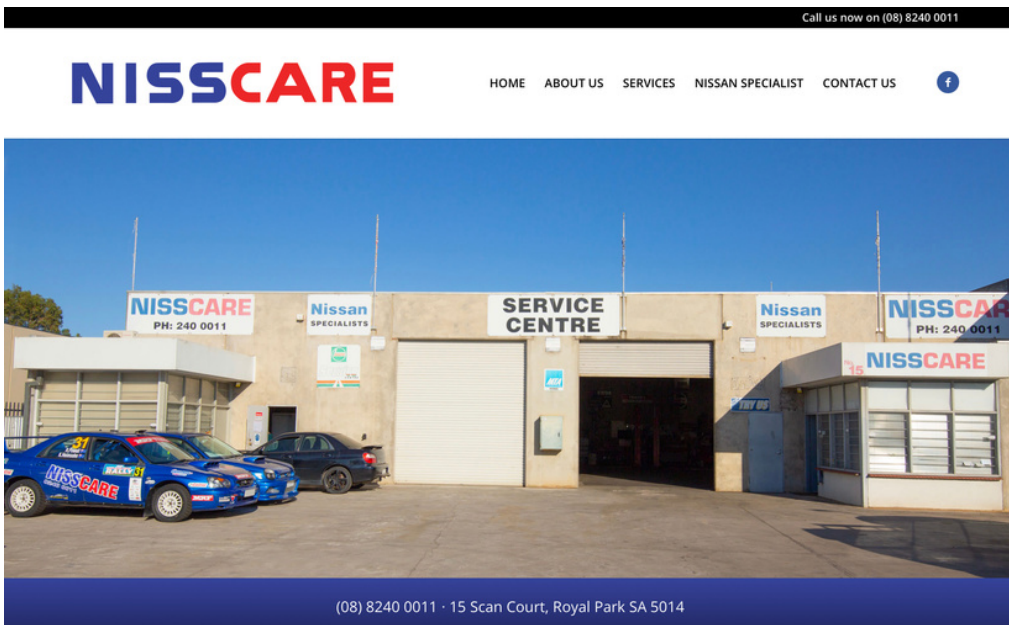

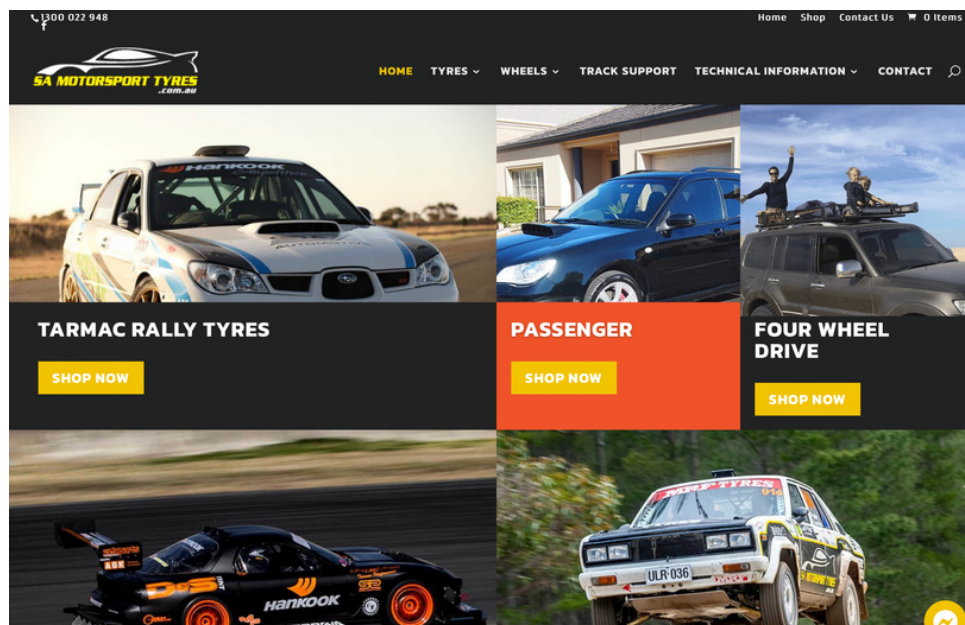

This changed the podium with Stephen and Dave taking the win, with Emma and Ross 2nd and Graham and Richard in 3rd.
